DEADLINE TO COMPLETE AODA ASSESSMENT: _____

- This listing is not all-inclusive and other programs may qualify. If you know of a qualified doctor/counselor/clinic where you would prefer to have your AODA assessment and follow-up sessions completed, please check with them to see if they have a qualified program.
- To insure proper credit is received for the AODA assessment completion, Defendant must inform the facility or agency that he/she is taking the AODA Assessment as a result of a Court action, and that the facility or agency must notify the Court office of completion on or before the assigned deadline.
- If extenuating circumstances make it impossible for you to complete the AODA assessment by the deadline, please contact the Court office to request an extension.
- Failure to contact the Court or complete your AODA assessment by the assigned deadline will cause a default Judgment to be entered against you, without further notice or hearing, and the TOTAL FORFEITURE and/or DRIVER'S LICENSE SUSPENSION will be enforced.
- If the total forfeiture is not paid, the Department of Motor Vehicles will suspend your Driver's License for failure to pay for up to two (2) years; or suspend your ability to obtain a Driver's License for up to two (2) years upon application.
